Advent and Christmas



A dvent is fast approaching. The News has been full of gloom, so it feels like a good time to bring some light and life to our church and neighbourhood with some Christmas cheer. Aware of the ever-tightening purse strings, we would like to share some ideas for a "Buy Nothing New" celebration.

Central to this is an Eco-Friendly Christmas Tree Festival, on Saturday 10th December from 11am to 4pm and Sunday 11th December from 1pm to 3pm. Café Church for Advent will be at 3pm on that Sunday. Setting up trees and decorations will be on the Friday evening, 9th, from 7pm, and on the Saturday morning from 9 till 11. Please let me know if you can provide or set up a Christmas Tree on behalf of your organisation or family. It would be good if you could have a verse or words from a Christmas carol or the Bible with your tree.

To prepare for this there will be an Eco-Friendly Christmas Craft session on the morning of 3^{rd} December, 10am to 12 noon. We will be asking people to bring bits of ribbon, string, pretty paper, card, fir cones, beads and buttons, anything with which we may make decorations, both for the Festival and to take home. There will be no charge for the session, but donations towards our Larkfield Warm Space will be very much appreciated.

We also hope to have a stall of new and nearly new children's toys and books both at the craft morning, and at the Christmas Tree Festival. Again, donations will be welcome towards our Larkfield Warm Space.

The Junk Nativity Scene which we had planned for outside the church will not now take place (unless someone offers to take this on), because we are busy with our Larkfield Warm Space which will open on Monday 21st November in the Sycamore Tree. Instead of a Junk Nativity, there will be a **Teddy Bears' Nativity Scene**, in a play Post Office, which we will prepare at Breakfast Church on 4th December and Little Larks on 7th December, ready for the Christmas Tree Festival (indoors). If you have any (pre-loved) teddy bears who would like to take part, please make sure they arrive in good time.

As in previous years, the Craft Group are preparing knitted Nativity characters to go in the windows of local shops and businesses, and the Travelling Nativity set will visit 4 families before Christmas.

Messy Church and Christingle will be on Wednesday 21st December, split into two groups again with the younger ones at 1.30pm and older ones at 3pm.
